TOP 10 BUDGET-FRIENDLY DOMESTIC ROUTES

1. Atlanta (ATL) ↔ Orlando (MCO)

Average fare: \$89-\$149 roundtrip

Why it's cheap: Massive competition, United hub advantage

Best time: January-February, September-October

Pro tip: Fly Tuesday/Wednesday for lowest fares

 **Current pricing:** Call **+1 (844) 213-73-19**


2. Detroit (DTW) ↔ Las Vegas (LAS)

Average fare: \$120-\$180 roundtrip

Why it's cheap: High frequency, leisure destination

Best time: Mid-week travel, avoid major conventions

Bonus: Often includes free checked bag on this route

 **** Check availability:**** Call **+1 (844) 213-73-19**

3. Minneapolis (MSP) ↔ Phoenix (PHX)

Average fare: \$110-\$170 roundtrip

Why it's cheap: Snowbird route with high capacity

Best time: November-April (peak snowbird season has deals)

Insider tip: Book 6-8 weeks out for best rates

 **Compare dates:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

4. Salt Lake City (SLC) ↔ Los Angeles (LAX)

Average fare: \$95-\$155 roundtrip

Why it's cheap: United hub to major market, heavy competition

Best time: Year-round consistent pricing

Sweet spot: Tuesday 6 AM departures often under \$100

 **Find cheapest days:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

5. New York (JFK/LGA) ↔ Miami (MIA)

Average fare: \$130-\$200 roundtrip

Why it's cheap: High-volume route, multiple daily flights

Best time: May, September-early December

Hack: JFK usually cheaper than LGA by \$20-40

 **Compare NYC airports:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

6. Seattle (SEA) ↔ San Diego (SAN)

Average fare: \$105-\$165 roundtrip

Why it's cheap: West Coast competition, Alaska Airlines rivalry

Best time: January-March, October-November

Tip: Non-stops are only \$10-20 more than connections

 **Current deals:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

7. Boston (BOS) ↔ Fort Lauderdale (FLL)

Average fare: \$125-\$185 roundtrip

Why it's cheap: Snowbird route, JetBlue competition

Best time: Off-peak (May-early June, September-November)

Note: FLL often \$30-50 cheaper than nearby MIA

 **Compare South Florida airports:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19


8. Chicago (ORD) ↔ Denver (DEN)

Average fare: \$110-\$175 roundtrip

Why it's cheap: Business route with weekend deals

Best time: Saturday departures, Sunday returns

Pattern: Prices drop Thursday evenings for weekend travel

 **Weekend specials:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

9. Portland (PDX) ↔ Salt Lake City (SLC)

Average fare: \$100-\$160 roundtrip

Why it's cheap: United's PNW-to-hub connector

Best time: Year-round, especially Tuesdays

Advantage: Often earns double miles on promotions

 **Check promotions:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

10. Washington DC (DCA/IAD) ↔ Atlanta (ATL)

Average fare: \$115-\$175 roundtrip

Why it's cheap: Business corridor with leisure pricing

Best time: Weekends (business travelers gone)

Tip: DCA usually more convenient, IAD sometimes \$15-25 cheaper

 **Compare DC airports:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19



BEST BUDGET INTERNATIONAL DESTINATIONS

1. Cancun, Mexico (CUN)


Average fare: \$250-\$400 roundtrip from Eastern USA

Why it's budget-friendly: Heavy competition, high capacity

Best departure cities: Atlanta, Detroit, NYC, Boston, Minneapolis

Peak savings: April-May, September-October

Bonus: All-inclusive resorts offer great package deals

 **Package options:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

2. Caribbean Islands (Various)

Puerto Rico (SJU)


- **Average:** \$220-\$350 roundtrip
- **Best from:** NYC, Atlanta, Orlando
- **US territory:** No passport needed!

Dominican Republic (PUJ, SDQ)

- **Average:** \$280-\$450 roundtrip
- **Best from:** JFK, Atlanta, Miami
- **Pro tip:** Punta Cana (PUJ) usually cheaper than Santo Domingo (SDQ)

Jamaica (MBJ)

- **Average:** \$300-\$475 roundtrip
- **Best from:** Atlanta, NYC, Detroit
- **Sweet spot:** Montego Bay has most United service

 **Caribbean comparison:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19 to compare ALL island options

3. Mexico City (MEX)

Average fare: \$280-\$450 roundtrip

Why it's affordable: United hub with competitive pricing

Best from: Atlanta, LAX, Houston area, Minneapolis

Cultural value: World-class city at budget prices

Tip: Midweek flights often \$100 cheaper than weekends

 **Current MEX fares:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

4. Reykjavik, Iceland (KEF)

Average fare: \$350-\$600 roundtrip

Why it's budget-friendly: Transatlantic competition with Icelandair, PLAY

Best from: NYC, Boston, Minneapolis

Best time: November-March (Northern Lights season!)

Bonus: Stopover program allows exploring Iceland + Europe on one ticket

 **Iceland packages:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

5. Dublin, Ireland (DUB)

Average fare: \$400-\$650 roundtrip

Why it's affordable: Major transatlantic hub, heavy competition

Best from: Atlanta, NYC, Boston, Detroit

Best time: February-April, October-November

Advantage: US preclearance = faster arrival

 **Dublin deals:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

6. Paris, France (CDG)

Average fare: \$450-\$750 roundtrip

Why it's budget-friendly: United's top European destination

Best from: All major hubs (ATL, DTW, MSP, JFK, LAX)

Best time: January-March, November

Flash sales: Paris often featured in big transatlantic promotions

 **Paris pricing:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

7. Liberia, Costa Rica (LIR)

Average fare: \$320-\$500 roundtrip

Why it's affordable: Growing destination, competitive market

Best from: Atlanta, LAX, MSP

Adventure value: Beaches, rainforests, and wildlife at budget prices

Tip: Liberia airport closer to beaches than San Jose (SJO)

 **Costa Rica options:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

HIDDEN GEM ROUTES (Underrated & Cheap)

1. Salt Lake City (SLC) ↔ Bozeman, Montana (BZN)

Average: \$150-\$220 roundtrip

Why go: Yellowstone access, skiing, outdoor adventure

Best time: June-September (summer), January-March (ski season)

Secret: SLC hub pricing makes Montana surprisingly affordable

 **Montana adventures:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

2. Detroit (DTW) ↔ Nashville (BNA)

Average: \$130-\$190 roundtrip

Why go: Music City on a budget, growing destination

Best time: March-May, September-November

Bonus: Often includes live music venue discounts for United passengers

 **Nashville packages:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

3. Minneapolis (MSP) ↔ Rapid City, South Dakota (RAP)

Average: \$140-\$210 roundtrip

Why go: Mount Rushmore, Badlands, Black Hills access

Best time: May-September

Value: National park trip at fraction of Yellowstone/Grand Canyon costs

 **Black Hills trips:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

4. Atlanta (ATL) ↔ Savannah (SAV)

Average: \$100-\$160 roundtrip

Why go: Historic charm, Southern hospitality, nearby beaches

Best time: March-May, September-November

Quick trip: Perfect for long weekends

 **Savannah getaways:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

5. Seattle (SEA) ↔ Boise (BOI)

Average: \$110-\$170 roundtrip

Why go: Outdoor recreation, emerging food scene, affordable

Best time: May-October

Hidden perk: Often empty middle seats on smaller aircraft

 **Pacific Northwest deals:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

HOW TO FIND YOUR BUDGET-FRIENDLY ROUTE

Step 1: Identify Your Nearest United Hub

Major United Hubs:

- Atlanta (ATL) - Largest
- Detroit (DTW)
- Minneapolis (MSP)
- Salt Lake City (SLC)
- Seattle (SEA)
- Los Angeles (LAX)
- New York (JFK/LGA)
- Boston (BOS)

Flying from a hub = 20-40% cheaper on average

 **Find your nearest hub:** Call **+1 (844) 213-73-19**

Step 2: Use United's Flexible Date Search

How:

1. Go to United.com
2. Enter your departure city
3. Leave destination BLANK
4. Select "Flexible Dates"
5. View map of cheapest destinations

Or call +1 (844) 213-73-19 and ask: *"What are the cheapest destinations from [your city] next month?"*

Step 3: Compare Route Alternatives

Example: Want beach vacation from NYC


Option A: Direct to Cancun - \$380

Option B: Connect through Atlanta to Cancun - \$290

Savings: \$90

Option C: Fly to San Juan instead - \$240

Extra savings: \$140

WHEN TO FLY BUDGET ROUTES

Cheapest Travel Months (Domestic):


- **January** (post-holidays)
- **February** (except President's Day week)
- **September** (post-Labor Day)
- **Early December** (before holiday surge)

Cheapest Travel Months (International):

- **January-February** (Europe)
- **May** (Caribbean/Mexico)
- **September-October** (Most destinations)
- **November** (Everywhere except Thanksgiving)

Most Expensive (Avoid These):

- Late December (Christmas/New Year)
- Late June-Early August (summer peak)
- Spring break weeks (March)
- Major holiday weekends

 **Flexible dates?** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19 for cheapest month to visit any destination

BUDGET ROUTE BONUS TIPS

Tip 1: Connecting Flights = Big Savings

Direct NYC→LAX: \$380


Connect via ATL: \$240

Time cost: +2 hours

Savings: \$140

Worth it for: Leisure travel, budget trips, flexible schedules

Skip for: Business travel, tight timelines

 **Connection options:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

Tip 2: Secondary Airports Save Money

Major vs. Secondary:

- NYC: JFK (\$\$) vs LGA ()vsEWR() vs EWR ()vsEWR()
- LA: LAX (\$\$) vs BUR ()vsLGB() vs LGB ()vsLGB()
- Chicago: ORD (\$\$) vs MDW (\$)
- DC: DCA (\$\$) vs IAD ()vsBWI() vs BWI ()vsBWI()

Average savings: \$30-80 per ticket

 **Compare all airports:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

Tip 3: Nearby Destination Substitutes

Want Hawaii but it's expensive? → Try Puerto Rico (no passport, often half the price)

Want Paris but too costly? → Try Dublin or Reykjavik (cheaper gateways to Europe)

Want Cabo? → Try Cancun or Puerto Vallarta (similar experience, less cost)

 **Alternative suggestions: Call +1 (844) 213-73-19**

Tip 4: Use SkyMiles on Expensive Routes, Cash on Cheap Ones

Smart strategy:

- **Cheap route (ATL→MCO \$120):** Pay cash, earn miles
- **Expensive route (LAX→Sydney \$1,400):** Use miles redemption

Why: Maximize value of each mile (worth more on pricey routes)

FROM MIDWEST (DET, MSP, CHI):


Cheapest domestic:

- Las Vegas (\$120-190)
- Phoenix (\$110-175)
- Florida (\$140-210)

Cheapest international:

- Cancun (\$310-480)
- Iceland (\$380-620)

- Mexico City (\$290-450)

 **Midwest specials:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19


FROM WEST COAST (LAX, SEA, SFO, PDX):

Cheapest domestic:

- Las Vegas (\$80-140)
- Hawaii (\$280-450)
- Phoenix (\$100-160)

Cheapest international:

- Mexico (various) (\$220-380)
- Costa Rica (\$340-520)
- Belize (\$350-550)

 **West Coast routes:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19


FROM SOUTH (ATL, MIA, DFW, HOU):

Cheapest domestic:

- Florida intra-state (\$80-140)
- Nashville (\$100-160)
- New Orleans (\$110-170)

Cheapest international:

- Caribbean (all islands) (\$200-350)
- Mexico (\$240-380)
- Central America (\$280-450)


 **Southern deals:** Call +1 (844) 213-73-19

THE ULTIMATE BUDGET ROUTE STRATEGY

For Maximum Savings:

1. **Fly from United hub** (or connect to one)
2. **Travel Tuesday/Wednesday/Saturday**
3. **Book 6-8 weeks out** (domestic) or 3-5 months (international)
4. **Avoid peak seasons** and holidays
5. **Consider connections** over nonstops
6. **Check secondary airports**
7. **Use flexible date search**
8. **Call +1 (844) 213-73-19** before final booking

Following this formula = **40-60% savings on average!**

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Are budget routes less safe? A: No! All United flights meet same safety standards regardless of price.

Q: Do cheap routes have worse service? A: Service is consistent. Price varies by demand/competition, not quality.


Q: Can I earn miles on budget fares? A: Yes! Even Basic Economy earns SkyMiles.

Q: Are there hidden fees on cheap routes? A: Basic Economy has restrictions (no carry-on, etc.). Main Cabin includes standard amenities. Ask **+1 (844) 213-73-19** for details.
