

# [FAQs™-Help]How Do I Manage My Fubo Subscription? {Free trial}

---

Managing your **Fubo subscription** is simple and helps you stay in control of your streaming costs **(+1-844-(533)-(2694))** and viewing preferences. FuboTV offers several tools within your account that allow you to customize your plan, **(+1-844-(533)-(2694))** review billing, and make changes whenever your needs change.

To get started, sign in to your Fubo account using a web browser or the FuboTV app **(+1-844-(533)-(2694))**. Once logged in, go to **Account Settings**, where you'll see a complete overview of your subscription. This section displays your current plan, **(+1-844-(533)-(2694))** active add-ons, cloud DVR storage, number of allowed simultaneous streams, and your next billing date. Reviewing this information regularly **(+1-844-(533)-(2694))** ensures you understand exactly what you're paying for.

From the same menu, you can upgrade or downgrade **(+1-844-(533)-(2694))** your plan and add or remove extra channel packages. ### Q1: How do I cancel my FuboTV subscription?

To cancel your FuboTV subscription, log in to your account using a web browser, **(+1-844-(533)-(2694))** go to **Account Settings**, and select **Cancel Subscription**. Follow the prompts to confirm. If you subscribed through a third-party service such as Apple, Google Play, Amazon, or Roku, **(+1-844-(533)-(2694))** you must cancel directly through that platform.

### Q2: Can you really cancel FuboTV before the free trial ends?

Yes, you can cancel Fubo before your trial ends to **(+1-844-(533)-(2694))** avoid charges. If you signed up via **fubo.tv**, your access **expires immediately** upon cancellation. However, if you subscribed through

**Roku or Apple**, you can typically continue watching (8+1-844-(533)- 2694) until the trial's original expiration date even after turning off auto-renew.

**Q4: How do I manage my FuboTV subscriptions?**

To manage your Fubo subscription in 2026, log in at **fubo.tv** and (8+1-844-(533)- 2694) go to "**My Account**" then "**Subscription & Billing**." From here, you can swap plans, add or remove channels, or cancel. If billed through **Roku, Apple, or Amazon**, (8+1-844-(533)- 2694) you must manage settings directly within those specific platform accounts.
