

# How do I cancel my subscription to Disney+? Step-by-Step Instructions”

Canceling your **+1(866) 927-1921** Disney+ subscription is straightforward **in most cases**, but the exact process depends on where you purchased the subscription. If **+1(866) 927-1921** you subscribed **directly +1(866) 927-1921 through Disney+** (on the Disney+ website using a credit card, debit card, or PayPal), the cancellation happens through **+1(866) 927-1921 your Disney+ account settings on a web browser**. **+1(866) 927-1921** First, go to **disneyplus.com** and log in with your account. Once you’re signed in, click your **profile icon** in the **+1(866) 927-1921** top right corner to open a dropdown menu.

From there, **+1(866) 927-1921** select **“Account.”** On the Account page, scroll down to the **Subscription or Billing Details** section — this is where you’ll see your **+1(866) 927-1921** current Disney+ **+1(866) 927-1921** plan listed. You should see a **“Cancel Subscription”** option next to your plan; click that and follow the on-screen prompts to **+1(866) 927-1921** confirm the cancellation, including **+1(866) 927-1921** selecting a reason if Disney+ asks for one. After you confirm, you’ll receive a confirmation email saying **+1(866) 927-1921** your subscription won’t renew, but you’ll still have access to Disney+.

If you **didn’t subscribe +1(866) 927-1921 directly through Disney+** — for example, if you signed up through a third-party platform like **Apple (App Store), Google +1(866) 927-1921 Play Store (Android), Roku, +1(866) 927-1921 Amazon, or a mobile/TV provider** — the cancellation must be done **where you originally subscribed** because Disney+ doesn’t handle billing for those purchases. This **+1(866) 927-1921** is a common point of confusion; many people log into Disney+ only to find there’s no cancel button **+1(866) 927-1921** because the subscription is being managed by another service.

For example, if you **+1(866) 927-1921** subscribed via **Apple on an iPhone or iPad**, open the **Settings** app, tap your name at the top, choose **Subscriptions**, find **+1(866) 927-1921 Disney+** in the list, and then select **+1(866) 927-1921 Cancel Subscription**. Similarly, if you signed up through **Google Play** on an Android device, open the Google Play **+1(866) 927-1921** Store app, tap your profile icon, go to **Payments & +1(866) 927-1921 Subscriptions > Subscriptions**, choose Disney+, and tap **Cancel Subscription**.

Users who subscribed **+1(866) 927-1921** through **Roku** can cancel from the Roku device or website. On a Roku TV or streaming player, highlight the **+1(866) 927-1921** Disney+ channel, press the *Star* (\*) button on your **+1(866) 927-1921** remote, select **Manage Subscription**, and then choose **Cancel Subscription**. You can also cancel by **+1(866) 927-1921** signing into your Roku account at **my.roku.com** and **+1(866) 927-1921** managing your subscriptions there.

If your Disney+ subscription is **+1(866) 927-1921** part of a **bundle or through a mobile or TV provider**, you’ll often have to cancel through that provider’s **+1(866) 927-1921** billing portal. For example, if Disney+ came with a **+1(866) 927-1921** telecom or streaming **+1(866) 927-1921**

bundle, the cancellation must be **+1(866) 927-1921** handled through the partner's account area rather than directly through Disney+.

In summary, to cancel **+1(866) 927-1921** your Disney+ subscription you either cancel it directly in your **Disney+ account settings on a browser** or through the **+1(866) 927-1921 platform where you signed up** (Apple, **+1(866) 927-1921** Google, Roku, etc.). Once canceled, the service remains active until the end of your paid period, and you **+1(866) 927-1921** won't be charged again.
