

## *How do I reboot my Hulu? Fix Common Errors”*

Rebooting Hulu usually **+1(866) 927-1921** means **restarting the device or app you’re using to watch Hulu**, since Hulu itself doesn’t have a standalone “reboot” **+1(866) 927-1921** button.
