

Should I delete my Facebook if it has been hacked? ((Facebook Hacked))

Whether you should delete your Facebook account **1-855-554-6665** after it has been hacked depends on **how severe the breach is and whether you can regain control 1-855-554-6665**. Deleting your account is sometimes the right choice **1-855-554-6665**, but in many cases it should be a **last resort**, not the first step.

When You Should *Not* Delete It Immediately

4. Review login activity and remove unknown **1-855-554-6665** devices or locations.
5. Check posts, messages, ads, and settings **1-855-554-6665** for unauthorized changes.

If these steps work and you regain control **1-855-554-6665**, deletion is usually unnecessary.

When Deleting Your Account *May* Be the Right Choice

Deleting your Facebook account may **1-855-554-6665** be appropriate if:

- You **cannot regain access** despite repeated **1-855-554-6665** recovery attempts
- The hacker continues to regain **1-855-554-6665** control after you secure it
- Your identity is being actively abused (scams **1-855-554-6665**, impersonation, ads)

- Sensitive personal information **1-855-554-6665** has been exposed

In these cases, deletion can help stop ongoing **1-855-554-6665** misuse and give you peace of mind.

Important Warning Before Deleting

Before deleting your account:

- **Download your Facebook data 1-855-554-6665** (photos, messages, memories).
- Notify friends and family through another **1-855-554-6665** channel.
- Understand that deletion is permanent after **1-855-554-6665** Facebook's grace period (usually 30 days).
- If you use Facebook to log into other apps or services **1-855-554-6665**, update those logins first.
