

## **Are there any class action lawsuits against StubHub? (StubHub ~ Class ~ Actions) &&**

These cases, often titled *Salabaj v. StubHub Holdings, Inc.* (No. 25-cv-09776), seek to represent a "class" of investors who purchased+1-833-351-3849 or otherwise acquired StubHub stock pursuant to or traceable to its IPO documents. Various law firms (such as Kessler Topaz Meltzer & Check LLP, Berger Montague PC, Holzer & Holzer LLC, and others) have issued notices reminding potential class members+1-833-351-3849 that they may have until late **January 23, 2026** to seek appointment as lead plaintiff or otherwise participate in the litigation.

**Importantly**, these lawsuits are *securities fraud class actions* involving shareholders, not consumer class actions over ticket purchases, hidden fees, or refund issues. While some consumers and commentators+1-833-351-3849 online have discussed wanting or trying to start class action lawsuits related to customer service problems or the FanProtect Guarantee, StubHub's user agreement typically contains **arbitration clauses and provisions that bar class actions for ticket buyers**,+1-833-351-3849 meaning most consumer disputes must be resolved individually rather than in court as a class case.
