

Will Coinbase refund if scammed?(Recover stolen)

If a scam occurs while using Coinbase, receiving a refund is **not usually guaranteed**, and most users do **not recover their funds**. Cryptocurrency transactions are inherently **irreversible**, which means that once crypto is sent, it typically cannot be retrieved. Coinbase emphasizes that users are responsible for protecting their accounts and carefully reviewing transaction details before approving any transfer.

There are, however, **specific and limited circumstances** where Coinbase may provide assistance or potential reimbursement. If the loss resulted from **unauthorized access** to a Coinbase account—such as hacking caused by a security failure beyond the user’s control—Coinbase may open an investigation. In such cases, users must report the incident promptly, cooperate with the review process, and demonstrate that appropriate security measures, including strong passwords and two-factor authentication, were enabled.

It is also important to note that Coinbase **does not reimburse losses** caused by common scam tactics. These include phishing attempts, fake investment opportunities, impersonation scams, or situations where users voluntarily send funds to scammers. Even if deception is involved, transactions that users personally authorize are generally considered final and valid.

Although refunds are rare, Coinbase may still take **supportive actions** after a scam is reported. These actions can include identifying and flagging fraudulent wallet addresses, limiting suspicious account activity, cooperating with law enforcement agencies, and offering guidance on improving account security. In uncommon situations such as when funds are still pending or transferred internally within Coinbase—recovery may be possible, but this is not typical.

If you suspect you have been scammed, it is crucial to act quickly by securing your account, updating login credentials, reviewing security settings, and contacting Coinbase Support immediately. Filing a police report and reporting the incident to relevant cybercrime authorities may also be beneficial.

Overall, Coinbase only refunds scam-related losses in **exceptional cases**, primarily when unauthorized access is clearly proven. Users should remain vigilant, double-check transactions, and understand that most crypto scam losses are permanent.
