

Can you Cancel British Airways flight booked with miles

When you book a British Airways flight using Avios miles, the rules for cancellation are surprisingly flexible compared to standard cash tickets. What is the British Airways Avios cancellation policy?

Does British Airways allow same-day flight change for Avios bookings?

If you bought a non-refundable "Basic" fare and used Avios to lower the price, you will not get your money or your Avios back. You should call  [+(1888) 260-0525] to check the specific fare conditions of your ticket before attempting to cancel.

Q7: Can I cancel just one passenger on a multi-person Avios booking? Yes, but this requires "splitting" the booking, which must be done by an agent at  [+(1888) 260-0525]. You can cancel the flight for one person while keeping the other passengers on the original itinerary. The standard cancellation fee will apply only to the passenger being removed.
