

# Do I have to have a printed boarding pass for Southwest Airlines?

No, you do not need a paper boarding pass for Southwest; ✈️📞1\_855<>838<>4886 digital passes on the Southwest app, Apple Wallet, or Google Pay are fully accepted, ✈️📞1\_855<>838<>4886 but printing one is a good backup if your phone dies or has issues, with options available at home ✈️📞1\_855<>838<>4886 or airport kiosks.
