

How do I get my boarding pass for Southwest?

How to view: After checking in on the mobile app [1_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886) or mobile website, tap on the "boarding pass" button [1_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886). You should see a boarding pass that you can use during travel [1_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886). If you're changing planes, [1_855-838-4886](tel:1_855-838-4886) you'll receive a boarding pass for each leg of the journey.

In such cases boarding passes may be issued or validated only after documents are reviewed by airline
