

How do I get my boarding pass on Air France?

You can check in online  1_855<>838<>4886 and receive your mobile boarding pass by e-mail for the majority of our flights  1_855<>838<>4886 . You cannot check in online if: - Your trip includes travel by train (except from Strasbourg or Brussels)  1_855<>838<>4886 . - You used Flying Blue Miles online to obtain an upgrade  1_855<>838<>4886.
