

How to manage pop ups in firefox

We will assume you are **Support Number +1877-514-1396** correct about this being a SPAM popup. If so, your computer is infected and needs to be cleaned with some spyware cleaner software like MalwareBytes Anti-Malware or Spybot Search and Destroy. Get the FREE version.

How? It's pretty simple for a programmer to create a fake CLOSE button. You could create an image at top of the window that

"look like" the Min, Restore and Close buttons, but does nothing. Or maybe the whole window is a single image and not a working window. Or you could disable the Close button in the code of the window.....

At the upper right, click the Tools image, and select Internet decisions.

Snap the Privacy tab.

Check or uncheck Turn on Pop-up Blocker.

Note: To get to forefront features, in the "Jump up Blocker" region, click Settings...

Web Explorer 8 and 7

From the Tools menu, select Pop-up Blocker.

Snap to pick either Turn Off Pop-up Blocker or Turn On Pop-up Blocker.

As per normal procedure, Internet Explorer demonstrates pop-ups that show up in view of clicking an association or catch. Jump up Blocker squares pop-ups that are appeared (without your clicking an association or catch). **+1877-514-1396** To allow a specific site to indicate customized pop-ups:

Snap Tools, select Pop-up B[locker, and a while later snap Pop-up Blocker Settings.](#)

[In the "Address of site to allow" box, type the area \(or URL\) of the site you have to see pop-ups from, and after that click Add.](#)

Repeat arrange 2 for each site you have to allow pop-ups from. When you are finished including destinations, click Close.

Firefox

In Windows, from the Tools menu, select Options...

If the menu bar is disguised, press Alt to make it unquestionable.

In Mac OS X, from the Firefox menu, select Preferences...

Snap Content.

Check or uncheck Block Popup Windows.

While discouraging pop, Firefox demonstrates an information [+1877-514-1396](#) bar, similarly as an image in the status bar. When you click either the Options get in the information bar or the image in the status bar, a menu is appeared with the going with choices:
