Missing a Wizz Air flight can be a stressful experience, but understanding the airline's policies can help you manage the situation efficiently. Wizz Air is a low-cost European carrier, and like many budget airlines, it operates with strict rules regarding missed flights and ticket changes. If a passenger misses their flight, the consequences and options depend largely on the **type of ticket purchased**, whether the flight was **part of a connecting itinerary**, and the **timing of the missed flight**. Instead, passengers may be able to **purchase a new ticket**

at the current fare price, which is often significantly higher than the original ticket, especially if booked at short notice. In some cases,
